17. Concussion Management - Dave Lee

• Rob M and Dave have been approached by Woolwich Physiotherapy and they will be meeting with them about how they can enhance our concussion program.

18. Spiritwear – Leanne Rollins

- PKSportswear will be cutting us a cheque for upwards of \$500 for the year (specific amount to be calculated at the beginning of April but as of February, it was sitting at just over \$500).
- Sportzone Bauer bucks amount is \$1350 for this year. However for next year, it will be less, as per this information from Vince: "The last 2 years the incentive program was 2% of gross sales to be put towards equipment purchased at their MSRP. The gross sales of Woolwich product so far this year was \$34 K \$29,767K was Bauer, Doing some quick math that works out to about \$600. However when we first started this program they gave us \$1350 in Bauer bucks and that was based on participation in 3 categories, team apparel, equipment, and jersey and or socks. I got Bauer to agree to the \$1350 for the 2015/2016 season. The team apparel was good, the equipment and jersey socks was poor, Bauer will honour the \$1350 for the past year." So, I'm guessing this means next year we can expect \$600 for Bauer bucks.
- To be clear, PKSportswear agreed to 10% back to WMHA; whereas Sportzone is 2% (this was a surprise to me). As a result, I think we should go ahead and let PKSportwear also sell the Bauer jackets next year.

19. New Business

- Rob Moyer Social Media guidelines. Basically just allows us to have the conversation with someone who may cross the line with social media.
- Leanne Rollins Volunteer Bond Fee. Is it something to consider. Leanne to contact
 Grimsby and ask more questions about it to see how we might be able to implement it
 there.
- Constitution
 - Leanne to revise all updates and then will send via pdf to all executive members for voting.
- Exceptional player status: Rob is recommending to move to Major Atom or remove all together.
- A/AA At the end of every season, Woolwich will try out as A, after tryouts coach will
 approach executive and they are to decide whether they can go to AA status based on
 criteria listed.
