- Grand River meeting: Season starts Oct.5
- Playoffs start Jan.17 and end March 4
- Team Fees stay the same \$10/team
- IP program, 6-year olds cannot play novice unless it is to fill a roster (not enough 7-year olds).
- Failure to comply with the cross-ice format means the entire center will not be allowed to play in any tournaments. OMHA means business.
- GRLL are conducting a 2-year pilot project on the Midget Division. It is to review and catalogue the progression of penalty infractions to individual team members per season. This is only for GRLL games not tournaments. 3 sanctions: after 20 penalty minutesgame suspension, after 30 penalty minutes suspended for the rest of the season, after 2 game ejections- suspended 1 game and after another 2 ejections-suspended 1 game. It is the GRLL home Centre Contact's responsibility to inform the midget coaches of the status player's penalty infractions. Also, it is also the responsibility of the Home Centre Contact to get the midget home game sheets to the MDS within 7 days, unless there are suspensions, then it has to be sent within 3 days. It is to be sent electronically with copies of the front and back (photo or pdf) and the hard copy within 16 days.

- Rosters to be completed within 2 weeks of first game or the coach will get suspended until it is sent in.

7. VP Coaching – Paul Lucier

- Trainer Clinic mid November will require ice time

8. VP Player Development – Rob Hall / Josh Gruhl / Kurt Wilkie

- Our IP (initiation program) has now officially been "kicked off" as of Sat. 23rd. We have
 also obtained coaches for each of the programs (IP4, IP5 and IP6). A meeting with these
 coaches was held Wed. Sept 13th that detailed the new structure for our IP programs and
 the parameters that will need to be following in light of the direction handed down from
 Hockey Canada and the OMHA.
- New equipment has been purchased for the IP program. We have new nets, cross ice bumpers as well as new blue pucks. We also need to review goalie equipment for this program. I believe we need to have enough goalie equipment available to support goal tenders for each of the programs. Kevin Brown should prepare a summary of the current available equipment we have in storage and from there a decision can be made whether to purchase any more.
- This coming Sat. (30th) our goalie clinic will begin for the season. Josh G. has been in contact with Steve Sumka regarding this year's format. Josh will be on the ice next Sat to assist with the clinic kick off.
- WHA development skates have now been entered into each REP teams calendar. Many teams have already hit the ice with Tony Code and his staff. Memos / reminders have also been sent out to all rep teams indicating that changes to development ice times will be few and far between
- New Equipment is store at the end of Snyder Rink. Goalie equipment will need to be purchased.
- All jerseys are in. Keeping the same colours so they can be used next year.
