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Rep Team Try-Out Schedule 2011-2012 Season

I am always amazed at how fast we come to this time of the year when everyone starts thinking of hockey and tryouts for the coming season.

As we continue to grow, changes occur and this year is no different with our Atom Rep teams playing at the AA level, along with the new Additional Player Movement Policy for 2011. Woolwich has made a commitment to participate fully in the Made for Ontario policy with the possibility of 3 non-resident players, playing on our Rep Teams from PeeWee to Midget. The tryouts will be open to all that qualify and have proper forms for the A level teams, all positions are open and if the non-resident players are selected during tryouts by the coaching staff they will be signed to that teams roster.

New

- Also new this year, a one time tryout fee of \$20 for rep teams that is payable at the first tryout the player attends.
- Should a player decide not to participate during the A tryouts but then start their tryouts at the AE level it will still be a \$20 fee.
- Please note that anyone wishing to tryout for a Rep team, including AE, must be at one of the first three ice times.
- It is expected that players will first go to the A level tryout and then to the AE once released from the A team.
- Anyone from Woolwich Township can try out for any team, but coaches can reduce the numbers after one ice time as they have limited ice available to pick their teams.

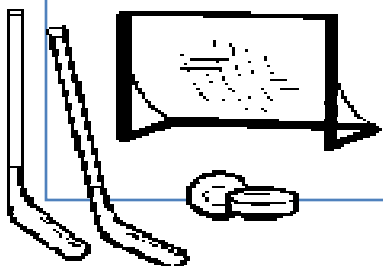

Concussion Management

WMHA are consider implementing a Mandatory Concussion Program for out 2011-2012 Representative teams. This would be a pilot program for next season with the anticipation of rolling it out across the association the following year. WMHA have met with the Clinical Medicine Research Group (CMRG) to better understand the program and the benefits that it provides. The CMRG concussion management program is the best in class and will help provide an even safer environment for our players to experience. More information to come.

WMHA will also be hosting education seminars on concussions as well as mouth guard clinics hosted by Bite Tech Under Armour in September.

The CMRG Concussion Management Program: 4 Steps to successful concussion management

Step 1: Education and information - CMRG provides education and information to players, parents, leagues and officials on the signs and symptoms of concussion and what to do when a concussion is suspected.

Step 2: Neurocognitive testing - CMRG provides baseline and follow-up ImPACT neurocognitive testing. Baseline testing is conducted at the start of the season each year (please see ImPACT information below).

Step 3: Proper Medical Management - CMRG has a network of over 240 healthcare providers across the country who are trained in proper concussion management. Once a concussion occurs, we work with the athlete/parent to ensure proper management by one of our medical experts.

Step 4: Research - CMRG, through our medical expert network and UWO ethics, work with teams and leagues to collect valuable data on concussion incidents. This information is then presented back to the leagues in order for them to enhance education programs, discuss possible rule or equipment changes, etc.



Overview and Features of the ImPACT Test

ImPACT (Immediate Post-Concussion Assessment and Cognitive Testing) is the first, most-widely used, and most scientifically validated computerized concussion evaluation system.

Developed in the early 1990's by Drs. Mark Lovell and Joseph Maroon, ImPACT is a 20-minute test that has become a standard tool used in comprehensive clinical management of concussions for athletes of all ages. ImPACT Applications, Inc. was co-founded by Mark Lovell, PhD, Joseph Maroon, MD, and Michael (Micky) Collins, PhD.

Given the inherent difficulties in concussion management, it is important to manage concussions on an individualized basis and to implement baseline testing and/or post-injury neurocognitive testing. This type of concussion assessment can help to objectively evaluate the concussed athlete's post-injury condition and track recovery for safe return to play, thus preventing the cumulative effects of concussion. In fact, neurocognitive testing has recently been called the "cornerstone" of proper concussion management by an international panel of sports medicine experts.
