Rep Team Try-Out Schedule 2012-2013 Season

I am always amazed at how fast we come to this time of the year when everyone starts thinking of hockey and tryouts for the coming season.

As we continue to grow, changes occur and this year is no different with our Atom Rep teams playing at the AA level, along with our Minor Pee Wee team playing AA and a new Minor PeeWee AE team that will play at the A level. We will also continue to participate with the Additional Player Movement Policy.

Woolwich has made a commitment to participate fully in the Made for Ontario policy with the possibility of 3 non-resident players, playing on our Rep Teams from Minor PeeWee to Midget.

The tryouts will be open to all that qualify and have proper forms for the A level teams, all positions are open and if the non-resident players are selected during tryouts by the coaching staff they will be signed to that teams roster.

We will continue this year, a one time tryout fee of \$20 for rep teams that is payable at the first tryout the player attends.

Should a player decide not to participate during the A tryouts but then start their tryouts at the AE level it will still be a \$20 fee.

Please note that anyone wishing to tryout for a Rep team, including AE, must be at one of the first three ice times.

It is expected that players will first go to the A level tryout and then to the AE once released from the A team.

The Minor PeeWee AE aged team players may choose to tryout for the traditional AE team should they wish to play with the two age groups. It has been indicated by the registration numbers that there should be enough players to field both teams. Please note that in fielding these two AE teams our intentions are to first field the traditional AE team.

Anyone from Woolwich Township can try out for any team in their age group, but coaches can reduce the numbers after one ice time as they have limited ice available to pick their teams.

Please let your coaches know if you want to be considered for the Rep team at the first skate. Scheduling information can be found on the Woolwich Minor Hockey website at www.woolwichminorhockey.ca.





Concussion Management

WMHA has implemented a Mandatory Concussion Program for all players atom and older. The CMRG concussion management program is the best in class and will help provide an even safer environment for our players to experience. More information to come.

WMHA has once again teamed up with CMRG and will be hosting education seminars on concussions in September.

The CMRG Concussion Management Program: 4 Steps to successful concussion management

Step 1: Education and information - CMRG provides education and information to players, parents, leagues and officials on the signs and symptoms of concussion and what to do when a concussion is suspected.

Step 2: Neurocognitive testing - CMRG provides baseline and follow-up ImPACT neurocognitive testing. Baseline testing is conducted at the start of the season each year (please see ImPACT information below).

Step 3: Proper Medical Management - CMRG has a network of over 240 healthcare providers across the country who are trained in proper concussion management. Once a concussion occurs, we work with the athlete/parent to ensure proper management by one of our medical experts.

Step 4: Research - CMRG, through our medical expert network and UWO ethics, work with teams and leagues to collect valuable data on concussion incidents. This information is then presented back to the leagues in order for them to enhance education programs, discuss possible rule or equipment changes, etc.



Overview and Features of the ImPACT Test

ImPACT (Immediate Post-Concussion Assessment and Cognitive Testing) is the first, most-widely used, and most scientifically validated computerized concussion evaluation system.

Developed in the early 1990's by Drs. Mark Lovell and Joseph Maroon, ImPACT is a 20-minute test that has become a standard tool used in comprehensive clinical management of concussions for athletes of all ages. ImPACT Applications, Inc. was co-founded by Mark Lovell, PhD, Joseph Maroon, MD, and Michael (Micky) Collins, PhD.

Given the inherent difficulties in concussion management, it is important to manage concussions on an individualized basis and to implement baseline testing and/or post-injury neurocognitive testing. This type of concussion assessment can help to objectively evaluate the concussed athlete's post-injury condition and track recovery for safe return to play, thus preventing the cumulative effects of concussion. In fact, neurocognitive testing has recently been called the "cornerstone" of proper concussion management by an international panel of sports medicine experts.
