- First time registrants must provide a copy of the player's birth certificate to WMHA and will always receive the early registration rate.
- A 10% discount applies to families with 3 or more participants.
- There is an additional fee of \$75 for all non Woolwich residents.

New to Woolwich? If you have just moved to Woolwich and you have previously played hockey with another association you will need to contact the hockey office for details on the transfer process.

Note: If your child decides not to play hockey in the fall you will be eligible for a refund. This refund will be pro-rated based on the date of withdrawal and a \$20 administration fee will be charged.
