c. VP Coaching - Rob Waters

- Concussion Management Program
 - 2 Seminars took place October 1st approx 25-30 people at each session
 - Good write up in the Observer covering the seminar
 - Return to play guidelines as well as concussion management literature on the website under the Concussion Management Tab (thanks Brian)
 - Currently 2 players going through the return to play process (issue with a Maj Bantam player getting in within 4-5 day timeline that has been addressed)
 - Working on invoicing with CMRG next week for the players that have completed the testing. approx 200 players have completed it.
 - Sent all the information to Dave Baker for the LL teams on the testing process. Currently there are only 3 LL players that have participated.
- Training Aids for dryland/off ice training/warm ups
 - We now have a lockbox in the North end of the Snyder Arena with the following items. The key is at the front desk and can be signed out for use before/after games.
